Phase Ia: Common Core Lesson Study Institute

either Session A: July 16-20, 8:30–3:30 (Focus on area in grades 3-5) or Session B: August 6-9, 8:30–3:30 (Open to all grade levels)

Working in teams, teachers focus on topic standards from the Common Core and one or two mathematical practices. Experts on the Common Core and experienced lesson study practitioners guide teams through developing a detailed unit plan and

research lesson plan.

Phase Ib: Implementing the Research Lesson

In Fall 2012, teams teach their research lessons and observe each others' lessons, with Lesson Study Alliance facilitating the discussions. Teams may choose to open their lessons to colleagues from their school or other schools, to share their ideas and promote discussion around the Common Core Standards.

Phase II: Lesson Study for Long-Term Improvement



With additional colleagues from their school, teachers plan two additional research lessons on the Common Core for winter and spring, using the 75-minute after-school common planning time. Lesson Study Alliance will provide support through site visits, video conferencing, and email.
