What is Lesson Study?

Lesson study uses a single, live lesson as the focus of professional learning. Teachers work together to plan a lesson that incorporates new ideas. While one teacher conducts the lesson, others observe how the lesson impacts the students. Afterwards, during the discussion, observers share their data to gain new insights into student thinking and effective teaching.

By focusing on the core tasks of teaching—lesson planning, teaching, observation, and reflection—lesson study creates steady, long-lasting improvement in education.
